1. Summary of main outputs - Road Maps

Based on Status Quo Analysis outputs the Road Maps was compiled, including areas where new activities should be set up or strengthened to date, leading to an overall innovation of education to ensure the development and competitiveness of the chemical industry in terms of human resources.

Five main areas have been defined and further broken down into the following themes:

1. Expanding communication with students and industry partners

Management discussions with students and employees Meeting of former graduates and employers with students of 4elements.

2. Study in practice – practice under study

Communication with Industrial Partners - website Communication with Industrial Partners and the Public - Facebook on faculties Extension of foreign communication and cooperation between universities.

3. Innovation of the structure of education

2. Enhance communication with students and industry partners

2.1 Management discussions with students and employees

Leading organization: UCT Prague *Sources of funding:* UCT Prague *Time schedule:* 2020 - continuously, app. once a year

The event is primarily activity of student representatives of the UCT Senate, with the participation of not only bachelor, master and doctoral students but also academic staff, academic senate members and faculty management.

2.2 Meeting of former graduates and employers with students of 4elements

Leading organization: UCT Prague

Sources of funding: UCT Prague, Sponsorship donations, partly funded by projects and grants. Inclusion of soft skills lectures is conditional on finding an external source of funding e.g. from EU funds.

Time schedule: 2020 - continuously, twice a year (summer and winter meetings).

The event is activity of the FTOP faculty, UCT Prague, held twice a year with participation of practitioners and former graduates of the faculty. There are also lectures for employees and students from soft skills.

3. Study in practice – practice under study

3.1 Communication with industrial partners - website design

Leading organization: UCT Prague

Cooperating organization: Association of Chemical Industry of the Czech Republic (ACI CR) potential employers of students UCT Prague students, SusChem ČR.

Sources of funding: UCT Prague, External financing via EU funds

Time schedule: design website content for the school Year 2017/2018, updating continuously.

In the first phase, a newly designed web will be serving as communication portal between the students, academic community and future employers. The content should consist primarily of excursion offers, short-term jobs for students, as well as job vacancies. In the next phase - the creation of websites with involvement of all faculties and the extension of the original website is envisaged by other activities related to increasing cooperation between academia and



industrial partners. Updating content will depend primarily on the activity and interest of potential employers of UCT Prague graduates.

3.2 Communication with Industrial Partners and the Public - Facebook on faculties

Leading organization: UCT Prague Cooperating organization: ACI CR, potential employers of students UCT Prague students Sources of funding: UCT Prague Time schedule: 2017, continuously

Updating content will depend primarily on the activity and interest of prospective employers of UCT Prague graduates.

3.3 Extension of foreign communication and cooperation between universities

Leading organization: UCT Prague Cooperating organization: foreign universities and scientific workplaces Sources of funding: UCT Prague partly, an external source of funding, such as EU funds, is necessary for the course of the action Time schedule: 2020 – updating continuously.

The course of this activity will depend on finding an external source of funding, especially for financing the travel costs of traineeships, workshops and negotiations on joint activities of the partners.

4.3 Inclusion of practice experience - solution proposals

The problem is very complex and its solution is given by inclusion of professional practices in the study plans as a part of teaching and evaluation of students by the educational institutions on one hand and a mandatory provision of necessary capacities for the implementation of the practice by industrial enterprises and institutions, while ensuring the legal requirements (labor code, SHE) on the other hand.

4.4 Further training of industrial partners - final version of the program

Leading organization: UCT Prague, ACI CR *Sources of funding:* UCT Prague *Time schedule:* 2017

The final plan of the educational program of the Institute of Energy will be updated according to the specific requirements of the enterprises cooperating with the Institute and offered to other faculty's industrial partners.

5. Increasing the attractiveness of the study

5.1 Changing the faculty name

This activity has already taken place, but the name of the faculty and its institutes has a great impact on the attractiveness of studies in these disciplines, and will continue to follow trends in the current scientific direction.

5.2 Experts from Practice - a lecture plan for the FTOP faculty

Leading organization: UCT Prague Cooperating organization: foreign universities and scientific workplaces, ACI CR, industry partners of UCT Prague Sources of funding: UCT Prague Time schedule: 2018, updating continuously



The purpose of this activity is to prepare a lecture plan of various disciplines aimed at increasing the level and competitiveness of graduates as well as academic staff of UCT Prague. For the next step, which is the organization of lecture blocks or seminars, it is essential to find an external source of funding.

5.3 Offer excursions to industrial operations to review current status and updates

Leading organization: UCT Prague, ACI CR Cooperating organization: industry partners of UCT Prague a ACI CR, SusChem ČR Sources of funding: UCT Prague, ACI CR, EU funds Time schedule: 2017/2018, updating continuously

In order to apply this activity, it will also be necessary to cooperate with industrial partners and their interest in future graduates of technical schools and interest in cooperation on their education.

5.4 Promoting Chemistry among the young generation

Leading organization: ACI CR, UCT Prague, SusChem ČR Cooperating organization: educational institutions CZ, industry Sources of funding: UCT Prague, ACI CR, educational institutions CZ, industry, ministries, ESF Time schedule: 2020 – continuously

The promotion of chemistry among younger generation is currently being or will be strengthened in the most attractive form through competitions for elementary school pupils and students of secondary chemical vocational schools and grammar schools. Organizational and financial support from the MEYS or the EU funds can be used for the implementation of the competitions, with the main sources of funding being continued by the industry and educational institutions.

6. National Qualifications System

6.1 Implementation of REACH Manager qualification

Leading organization: ReachSpektrum s.r.o. Cooperating organization: ACI CR, UCT Prague, FChT University of Pardubice Sources of funding: ReachSpektrum s.r.o. Time schedule: 2017/2018



Professional qualifications REACH manager is currently included in the National Qualifications Framework as an approved qualification. An authorized person will conduct authorized tests of qualified candidates. Candidates will be able to gain a necessary knowledge to pass the exam at educational institutions and through specialized seminars at specialized companies.

6.2 Revision of qualification Engineer Chemistry Product Manager

Leading organization: Sectoral Council for Chemistry under the National Qualifications Framework

Cooperating organization: ACI CR, UCT Prague *Sources of funding:* National Institute for Education *Time schedule:* 2017/2018

Professional qualifications have undergone revisions made by the Sectoral Chemistry Council, and the comments of authorizing bodies are currently being processed.

6.3 Design of a new professional qualification Engineer Chemistry Economist

The proposal for the a professional qualification focus is currently commended by the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MIT), the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs (MLSA) and the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport (MEYS). After an approval of the focus, the draft of the content of the professional qualification will be elaborated.
